

TOP GUN ARMWRESTLING TABLE

Thank you for purchasing the New Top Gun Armwrestling Table. It is like having 3 tables all in 1. The Armwrestling table is custom made of heavy duty materials and is made to last. This Armwrestling Table design has been in uses for over 20 yrs and it consist of 4 components, 1-Table Top, 2 Legs, and 1 Base. When assembled properly, this table will last for years in the armsport tournament environment.

The Top is 1 inch of plywood and redesigned for the 3 in1 table which will allow the elbow and pin pads to be 1)staggered for right hand competition or 2)staggered for left handed competition or 3)straight across for practice without moving the pads back and forth. The top is upholstered over with foam & vinyl and has side rails all the way around it and is padded on the competitors sides to keep the armwrestlers from getting injuries to the hips or side burses and scraps. The elbow & Pin pads are made of HD high density foam that last a long time and the elbow pads have a layer of neoprene rubber on top that gives it the extra firmness but not to hard. Special tool less wing nuts are used on the pads for quick change over. Great for competition.

The legs are 2 pieces of heavy steel tubing welded to 4" flat stock at each end for quick tear down and assembly of the arm wrestling table. The legs have been painted with powder coat which is a very durable paint and will last for many years.

The base is made of ¾ inch OSB wood and has been painted black, it is reinforced with 2x4's for a rock solid base which is required for use of this armwrestling table, it has been redesigned to fold in have for portability, storage, and shipping.

Assembly

TOOLS - the only tools needed is a 9/16 wrench or ratchet to tighten or remove the 4 bolts and 4 nuts.

NOTE - Do not tighten assembly nuts & bolts until all hardware has been put in place.

WARNING - Do not compete on table without a base, major damage may occur .
Do not store the base bolts in the assembled position when base is folded in half it may cause damage to the hinges if weight/pressure is applied. There is a storage place on the bottom side of the base.

STEP - 1 You will need approximately 60" X 40" for the base, Lay the base down in half so that the 4 assembly bolts in their storage space are facing up (Fig. 1). Remove the 4 bolts and washers and set them close by. Flip the other have of the base in the open position (Fig.2).

STEP - 2 Place the leg on the base with the longest end down(Fig 3). Line up the holes in the legs with the holes in the base (Note - if short end of legs are down, holes don't line up.). Use the hardware just removed from the base and start bolts by hand only(Fig.4). Always take precaution not to cross tread the bolts. **DO NOT TIGHTEN BOLTS ALL THE WAY DOWN**, keep bolts lose until top is installed.

STEP - 3 Remove the 4 - 3/8 nuts and washers from the bottom of the Top and place them near the base and legs. Set the top on the legs so that the bolts on the bottom side of the top sit on the legs(Fig.5). Align the bolts in the top so that they fall in the holes of the legs, do 1 leg at a time(Fig.6). (Note - this step may seem difficult at first, but will get easier every time you do it.) When all 4 bolts are threw the legs put the nuts and washer back on the table top bolts.

STEP - 4 Now the 4 bolts attaching the base and 4 nuts attaching the top to the legs need to be tightened down, when the nuts and bolts are snug, tighten 1/2 turn to 1 full turn. If table still feels lose, tighten all bolts another 1/2 turn. Until table is solid. Do not over tighten (420 inch lbs. Max). Table is now ready for competition.

Reverse steps for disassembly.

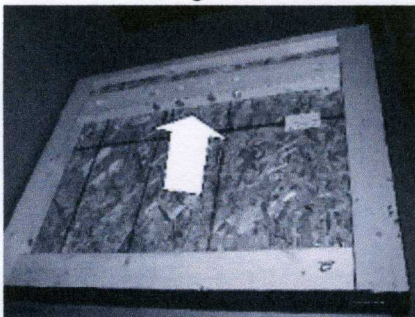

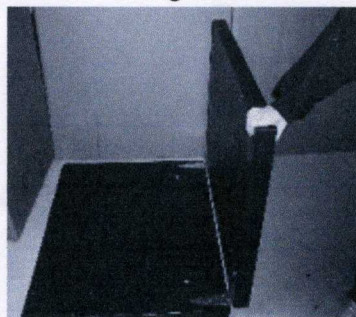

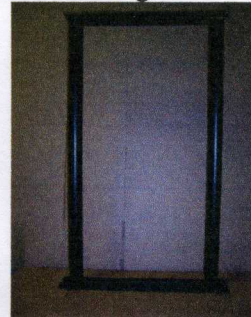

Top Gun 3 in 1 Pad Placement

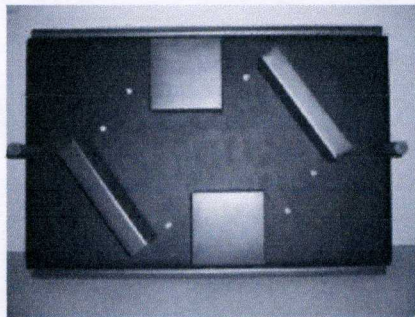
This table has been designed to be used as right handed, left handed or centered for both arms.

NOTE - 1) When removing a pad from it position it is possible that the bolts could catch on the eyelets, so you should put your hand on top of the table near the pad to hold the table top fabric down and jiggle the pad out.

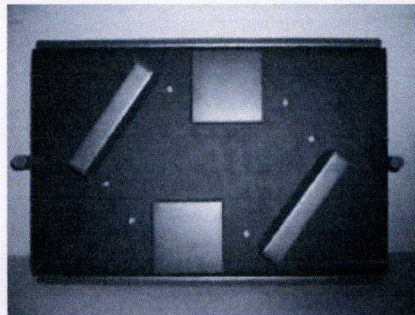
2) When installing the pads start both bolts threw the eyelets first, then proceed going threw the table holes. It is possible that the holes don't line up perfectly and you might have to jiggle the Pad threw the holes.

WARNING - Do not yank the pads out, or force them in, it may cause the eyelets to pull threw the fabric.

Right handed - Elbow pads are placed all the way to the right side of the competitors and pin pads are in staggered hole left of elbow pads.



Left handed - Elbow pads are placed all the way to the left side of the competitors and pin pads are in staggered hole right of elbow pads.



Centered - Place elbow pads in center of table with bolt pattern opposite as be staggered, then place the pin pads so that they will be in center position.

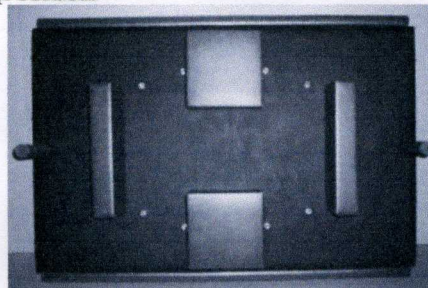
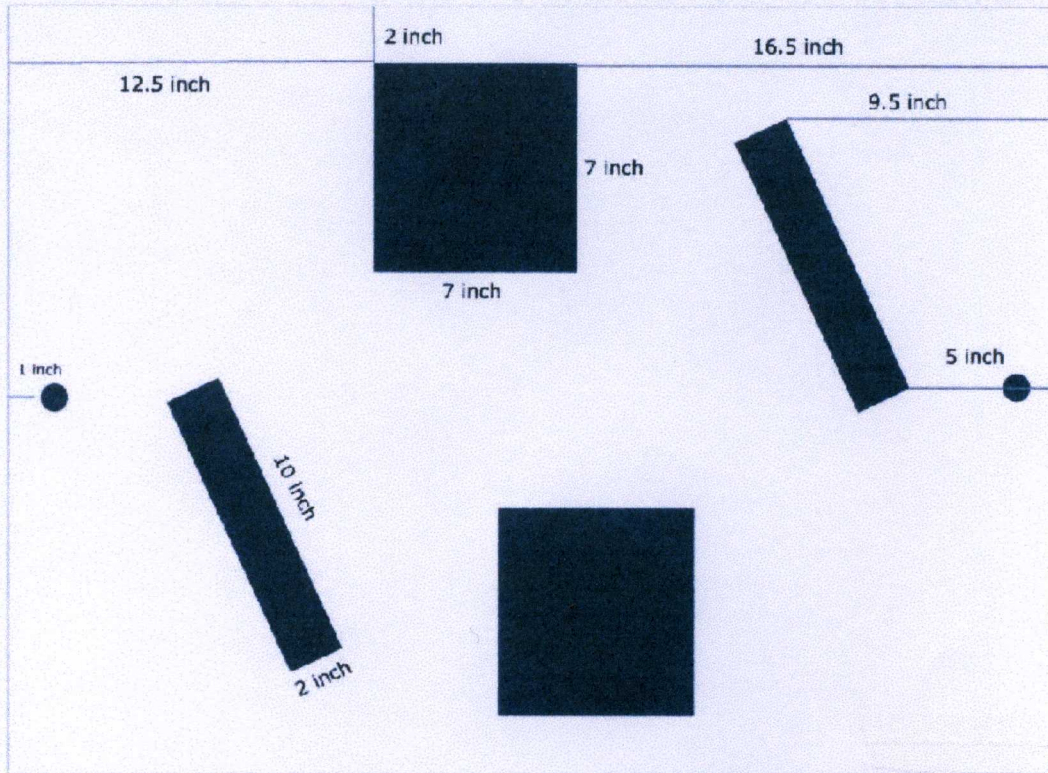


Table Dimensions

Table top is 36 inches. X 26 inches.
The height is 40 inches to the top of the table.
Pin Pads are 2in. wide X 10in. long X 4in. high.
Elbow Pads are 7in. wide X 7in. long X 2in. high.
Hand pegs are round 1in. across X 6 inches high.
Inside leg dimension is 28 inches wide and 18 inches deep.

This Warrantee is good from the date of purchase for 1 year from the original purchasers and is not transferable. The warrantee is void if the Manufacture is no long a valid business.
